

# Archie the Archaeologist



Archie the archaeologist is trying to locate 11 Roman artefacts buried on this site. Can you help him?

- The artefacts are buried either horizontally or vertically in the ground.
- They are evenly scattered across the site with clear space around each one (so none of the artefacts touch).
- The numbers along the edges of the grid show how many squares contain part of an artefact in each row or column.
- Each type of artefact takes up a different number of squares and has a different set of symbols, as shown below.

TIP: Use a pencil to fill in your guesses in case you get any wrong.

**CLUE:** Each symbol has rounded ends like this Ì  
The direction in which the symbol lies on the grid will indicate which way an artefact is lying in the ground, either horizontally or vertically. Shaded in squares show only soil.
