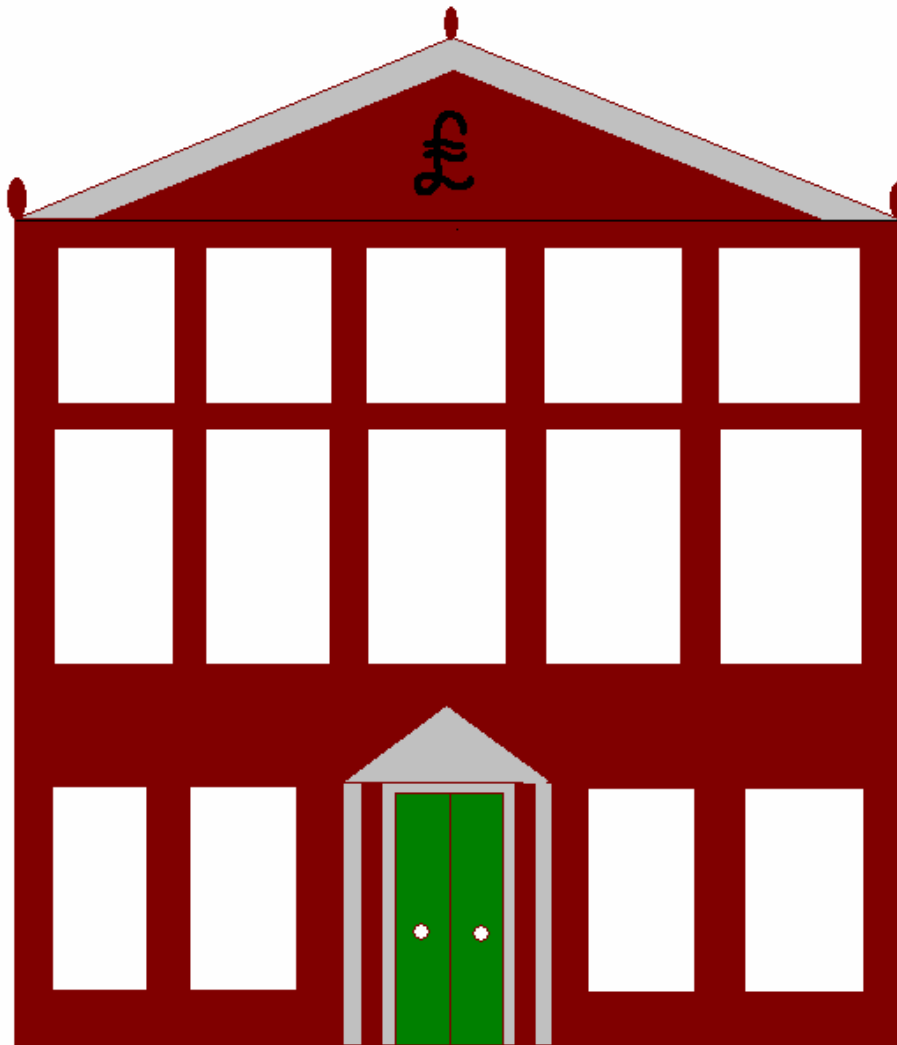


## Lord Skinflint's Window Tax



It is 1792 and Lord Skinflint of Pennypinch Hall has to pay a tax on the number of windows in his home. This is known as Window Tax.

- If he has between 10 and 19 windows he will pay 4 shillings.
- If he has between 7 and 9 windows he will pay 2 shillings.
- If he has 6 windows (or less) he will not have to pay any window tax.

Lord Skinflint does not want to pay any window tax at all. If he bricks up some of the windows in his home he will not be charged for them. How many windows will he need to brick up so as not to pay any window tax? (Remember he will need to keep some to let in the light!).

When you think you have worked out the answer brick up the correct number of windows in the drawing by colouring them in.
